# A Red Carpet Affair

Dear Parent/Guardian or Senior Students:

It is hard to believe that this school year is moving so quickly! It is time to prepare for our annual Senior Prom on **Friday May 29, 2009**. The Prom will be held from 6:00 p.m. until 11:00 p.m. at the Marriott Hotel in Newport, RI.

## **Tickets**

Prom tickets will be available for purchase from Mrs. Mancini in the guidance office Monday March 30, 2009 - Friday May 8, 2009. The ticket price of \$65 per student includes a three course dinner, unlimited soda bar, favors, DJ cost, and security charges. **The absolute last day to purchase tickets will be Friday May 8, 2009 – NO EXCEPTIONS.** Students are allowed to purchase a ticket for themselves and one guest. Students are allowed to bring one guest who does not attend Diman.

## **Reserving Tables**

To ensure students are able to sit with friends, students will have the opportunity to reserve a table before the prom. To reserve a table, all guests at the table must have paid for their tickets. Tables of 10 will be available. One person from the group will be responsible for completing the table reservation form and returning it to Mrs. Mancini **by Friday May 15, 2009**. It is recommended that students purchase tickets early to ensure that they receive preferred seating. If students do not have a full table of 10, they are not able to reserve a table ahead of time.

## **Parking**

Parking is available at the Newport Gateway Center, which is located next to the hotel. The Marriott offers a discounted rate of \$9. Students can purchase the \$9 validations at the front desk of the hotel or at the soda bar during the prom.

## **Attire**

The senior prom is a formal event and students will be asked to dress appropriately – no sneakers, jeans, t-shirts or revealing attire.

## **Admittance/Re-admittance Policy**

Students must have their tickets when arriving to the prom. Students who choose to leave the prom earlier than 11:00 p.m. will not be re-admitted.

**Chaperones/Security**

Members of the Diman administration and faculty will be chaperoning the prom. Police officers from the town of Newport will also be present. Students are expected to adhere to all hotel rules and school rules that are in place for any school event.

**Pictures**

Mare Studios will be available for formal pictures throughout the evening. The price list for picture packages is enclosed. When the pictures are ready they will be available for pick up at Diman.

We have set high expectations for both the prom and the behavior of the students attending. We understand that this is a very exciting time of year for you and your son or daughter. We have taken care that this evening is well planned with proper supervision. We ask for your assistance in communicating with your son or daughter about the importance of their behavior at this event and all senior events and that drugs and alcohol will not be tolerated.
