The New Deal: Roosevelt's economic program of *relief, recovery* and *reform* to pull America out of the Great Depression.

Objectives Of The New Deal:

- 1. To erase the banking crisis and impact financial reforms**
- 2. To aid the unemployed**
- 3. To aid in the recovery of industry**
- 4. To aid in the recovery of agriculture**
- 5. To aid homeowners and provide low-cost housing**
- 6. To conserve and protect the nation's resources**

Effects Of The New Deal:

- 1. Public Works Projects:**
 - built bridges, hospitals, schools, public housing for poor people, roads**
- 2. Work Relief Programs**
- 3. Increase in Federal Power**

- **takes power away from the states.**
- **the government plays a larger role in the**

lives of people

4. Creation of a "welfare state"

- **Ex. unemployment payments, social security, insured banks**

5. Big Government

- **an increase in government workers**
- **600,000 to 4,000,000**
