We will also be asking shop department heads if there are any student-made items that can be donated. We are still hoping to have the fundraiser in May.

## **Graduation Masks**

Michelle is in contact with someone who can make Diman graduation masks. The masks are black with an orange logo. They are washable/reusable and have a nose "clip". The cost is \$2.15 per mask. There are 349 graduating seniors, so we have decided to order 360 and offer them to seniors as a donation from the PTO. We will have the students vote for their favorite logo choice through Aspen.
