- I understand that the laptop I am issued is subject to inspection at any time without notice and remains the property of Diman Regional.
- I will follow the policies outlined in the Chromebook Agreement (laptops will follow the same policy as the Chromebooks) and the Greater Fall River Vocational District Technology District Technology Acceptable Use Policy while at school as well as outside the school day.
- I will file a police report in case of theft or damage caused by fire.
- I will be responsible in case of theft or damage caused by fire.
- I will be responsible for all damage or loss caused by neglect or abuse.
- I agree to pay the full replacement cost of my laptop, power cord/charger, in the event that any of these items are lost or damaged.
- I agree to return the laptop and power cord/charger in good working condition at the end of each school year.
- I have reviewed and agree to comply with the full laptop agreement.

LAPTOP AGREEMENT
Student/Parent Laptop Use Agreement 2020-2021

<p>TERMS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">You will comply at all times with the Diman’s Chromebook Policy Handbook (laptops will follow the same policy as Chromebooks) as well as the Diman Technology Acceptable Use Policy. Any failure to comply may terminate your rights of possession effective immediately and the school may repossess the property. Laptops are assigned to a single individual and are not to be shared.
<p>TITLE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Legal title to the laptops is to Diman Regional and it shall remain in the Greater Fall River Vocational School District. The student’s right of possession and use is limited to and conditioned upon full and complete compliance with this Agreement and the Chromebook Policy Handbook.
<p>LOSS OR DAMAGE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">If the property is accidentally damaged or incurs loss due to an act of nature, Diman regional will assess the laptop damage and repair or replace the device under the accidental loss or damage policy. If the property is stolen, a police report must be filed by the student or student’s parents/guardians involved in the loss of property. Loss or theft of the property must be reported to the School by the next school day after the occurrence. Fraudulent reporting of theft will be turned over to the police for prosecution.
<p>REPOSSESSION:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Students not complying with all terms of this Agreement and the Chromebook Policy Handbook, including the timely return of the property, will be declared to be in default and authorities may be sent to your place of residence or other location of the laptop to take possession.
<p>TERM OF AGREEMENT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Your right to use and possession of the property terminates no later than the last day of classes during the school year unless earlier terminated by Diman Regional or upon student withdrawal from Diman Regional or the Business Technology shop
<p>APPROPRIATION:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Your failure to timely return the property and the continued use of it for non-school purposes without the school’s consent will be considered unlawful.
