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STUDENT CLINICAL ROTATION AGREEMENT Medical Assisting

Clinical rotations are designed to be instructional in nature by providing students with hands-on experience. Clinical training is a cooperative effort between the school, student, and clinical rotation facility. Students who meet performance expectations and who are in good standing in shop and related classes with a current CPR and First Aid card will be placed at clinical rotation site by the junior instructor. It is the ultimate responsibility of the junior instructor to select site experiences according to the demonstrated mental and physical abilities of the student. It is the ultimate responsibility of the site to provide an opportunity to participate in hands-on skills while under the supervision of a site employee.

The site will provide an introduction to the policies and procedures of the facility. The site will retain full responsibility of the direct and indirect provision of services to patients. The site reserves the right to terminate affiliation for any student who does not conform to the site's standards for affiliating students.

Students are responsible for following site's policies, rules, and regulations while at the site. Students also have the following responsibilities, which if not-compliant will result in discipline by the instructor.

- Students will be respectful. Deliberate disruptive, profane or disrespectful words, actions, violence, or physical interference with the rights of patients, staff, or faculty will be met with school discipline and removal from the externship site at the discretion of the junior instructor.
- Students will be responsible. Students who will be absent on a clinical day must notify both their clinical site and the junior teacher of this absence. Any student who fails to notify their site and/or junior teacher of an absence before 9 AM on the date of the absence, will receive a zero for work readiness that day. Students email the junior teacher by 9 AM and provide information regarding what time they notified their site and who they spoke to.
- Students will be honest and true. Students will demonstrate integrity at all times during externship. Students that breach honesty and trust will be met with school discipline and removal from the externship site at the discretion of the junior instructor.
